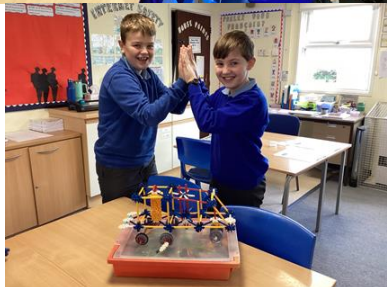


Kate and Freddie, our well being dog, have visited us all again this term. The children had a lovely time helping Freddie to find clues under the cones!

Reception have enjoyed retelling the story of David and Goliath in RE. The children learnt Christians believe that God is there to help them to be brave and strong.

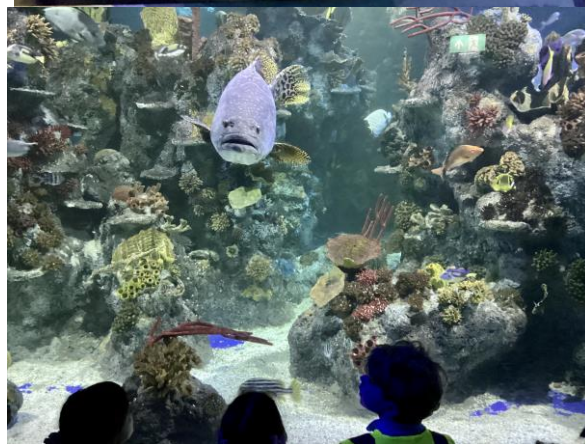
