Well done to George who has just been awarded a special golfing certificate for his participation in the sport!



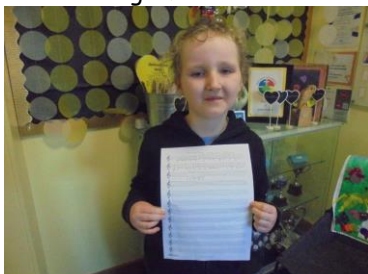
Little Deers have had a super time looking at patterns and spotting numbers in their environment. They have created patterns using lots of different toys and materials and tried to spot their age too.
