
School council have been busy sharing the big question of 'What makes a good school council member? - children from across school shared lots of great ideas such as 'show our school values' and 'caring for others'.



Congratulations to Ernie who won himself a rugby trophy for being 'Player of the Week' at Bredon Rugby Club! Well done Ernie!




Class 2 have been having a great couple of computing lessons creating a podcast about the Anglo-Saxons. They have all enjoyed recording, editing and creating digital media.
