All Things Wild aim to show the amazing things that nature can bring, whatever the weather. They offer a diverse range of activities that suit all ages and encompass the values that we hold as a school; that while animals are a great way of educating, they should be treated with respect and care. For this reason, they aim to keep the animals in an environment that is as close to their natural habitat as possible.
