3.	Where a pupil or staff member tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms more than 48 hours since last being in school (Monday 21st December – 24th December) the school should not be notified. Parents and carers should then follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.
