	ADVICE
1. Parents/carers and staff are informed that they must continue to inform the school of confirmed cases if <b>symptoms developed within 48 hours of last being in school.</b>	You <b>MUST</b> email in to <a href="mailto:admin@deerhurst.gloucs.sch.uk">admin@deerhurst.gloucs.sch.uk</a> <b>PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE A MESSAGE ON THE ANSWER MACHINE AS I WILL NOT BE IN SCHOOL</b>
2. Parents/carers of pupils and staff who were <b>not symptomatic but tested positive within 48 hours of last being in school also need to let the school know.</b>	You <b>MUST</b> email in to <a href="mailto:admin@deerhurst.gloucs.sch.uk">admin@deerhurst.gloucs.sch.uk</a> <b>PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE A MESSAGE ON THE ANSWER MACHINE AS I WILL NOT BE IN SCHOOL</b>
3. Where a pupil or staff member tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms <b>more than 48 hours since last being in school (Monday 21st December – 24th December)</b> the school <b>should not be notified. Parents and carers should then follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.</b>	The Local Authority will offer the COVID School Enquiries inbox to parents and carers from 21 <sup>st</sup> -24 <sup>th</sup> December. This will be covered from 9am-5pm each day. They will contact me if there is a positive case reported at this time.
