Home Learning

The time tables for your child's home learning are attached with this letter in the email. Each day has been planned and structured so that you can work through it as if the children were in school. We will 'register' your child into the lessons here at school virtually and your child will be in daily contact with their teacher receiving feedback and marking.

The protocol for our Home Learning attached to your original Home Learning Letter when we first set up See Saw has also been copied below to remind you of expectations.

Today your child will have access to maths from 1pm and you will be able to message your child's class teacher. As from 9am tomorrow and for the duration of the lockdown your daily Home Learning will be uploaded daily. There will be a variety of rich curriculum activities set for your children to enable them to progress with their learning from where they left it prior to lockdown. If your child is in school as a Key Worker child or vulnerable then they will be doing the learning that is posted on See Saw in their KW bubbles in school with staff on a rota. That will also mean on days they are not in school they can do the following days learning that has been posted for all children for those days. In doing this all children will be having the same learning opportunities that are consistent, mirrored and structured and will enable them to continue with their learning when they all return to school after lockdown. If everyone is able to complete the work set then learning will continue to move on for all children.

Feedback marking will be given by the children's class teacher and work will be set by their own class teacher on See Saw so they are able to continue with assessment for learning and understand their next steps in learning.

If you have any questions or queries please don't hesitate to ring or email into school. We will work together with the interests of the children at our heart and keep everyone safe.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide opportunity for children to access lessons at home • (Desk-tops/ laptops/ tablets are ideal. If there is an issue with providing these, please contact school who will do what they can to help) • Download SeeSaw online platform, which should have been downloaded in a previous testing • Ensure children log-in to each lesson and complete follow-up work • Ensure work is uploaded to their journal/page each day or when required to do so by the class teacher • Phone school in the usual way if their child is ill • Ensure children are logged on to See Saw • Ensure online safety guidance is followed • Ensure any work relating to the day's sessions has to be uploaded to individual portfolios by 3pm and children will be registered as 'attending' when the work has been uploaded • Ensure messages to staff are sent during the school day 08.30-3.30pm or if they are sent at times outside of this the expectation will be that they are responded to during school hours 	<p><u>On the first day of home learning the class teacher will:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Add a TT of expectations • Add weekly home learning to the child's journal/ page • Post links for daily video lessons to White Rose Maths or Oak academy, where appropriate for other subjects and any other videos as appropriate • Other subjects will be posted on school learning grid (like that seen in the previous lockdown) <p><u>On the second and subsequent days of home learning:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There will be 2/3 lessons available for each day and the time length will depend on age of children but will reflect school. • The lessons will primarily be English (writing/reading and Maths; • The class teacher will set follow up work to be completed after the lesson. Any worksheets will be downloaded and added to SeeSaw • Class teachers will take a register of those children taking part in the HL and lessons 'attended' • Class teachers will give a general comment for the work uploaded and will use the work to inform their teacher assessment
