We would like to take Reception and Year 1 children to visit The John Moore Museum on Wednesday 11th May 2022 for the morning only (children will be back at school for lunch and the afternoon). The John Moore Museum is nestled in a row of historic timber-framed buildings close to the Abbey in Tewkesbury, Gloucestershire.

The museum was established in 1980 in memory of the writer and naturalist, John Moore. Today, it is also home to an extensive Natural History collection featuring specimens of the mammals and birds native to our countryside, woodlands, wetlands and farmland.

The children will take part in workshops such as 'At home with the Tudors' where the children will take a tour of the 15th century Merchant's House with the merchant's housewife, try on historic clothing and discover what it was really like to live in the Tudor age.

We will be leaving by coach at 9:00 am and arrive back at school for 12:30pm. Children will need to bring a labelled water bottle and a morning snack for the morning in a backpack.

The cost of the trip and transport will be met by a voluntary contribution of £13.50. The deadline for permission should be returned to school by Friday 29th April in order for the trip to go ahead. Payment deadline is 3rd May 2022 via parent pay. Thank you for your continued support.
