Dear Parents/Carers,

Tuesday 5th January 2021

Key Workers/ Vulnerable Children

Your child/children fall into the above category and have been accepted to attend school to enable you to continue to carry out your key roles in relation to the coronavirus response. They will need to be brought into the school reception when they arrive please between 08.40- 9am, where they will have their temperatures checked as previously done.

I would appreciate a quick response to this offer of provision so we, as staff know how many children to plan for. I am happy for you to reply via email, by 2pm today, Tuesday 5th January if you are able to.

Can I please ask you to send in a packed lunch (in a disposable bag where possible), snack and a water bottle for your child's time in school. If you are unable to supply this please contact me at school.

Please fill in the TT below for the days that you require provision for and please read the expectations for attending. The TT will be set up with immediate effect.

All learning will be put onto See Saw for all children and this will include for KWs. This is the work they will do in school so that on the days they are not in school they have the same access as the children not in school to continue with their set work at home.



For children coming in to school the following measures/precautions must be taken:

- Own clothes to be worn which are fresh on – we recommend putting clothes straight in the washing machine once returning home from school to minimise and control the spread of infection.
- Up to date contact details for family members must be available within school and emergency contact details should your child become poorly/exhibit symptoms of contracting coronavirus. Please ensure you have updated us of any changes since the data collection form
- We must register your child in and out of the premises by somebody who either has parental responsibility or has been nominated by yourselves, as long as you are all fit and well and not showing symptoms of coronavirus.
- If you become unwell with coronavirus symptoms, you must **immediately** contact school and arrange for collection of your child.
- Social distancing **must** be enforced whilst your child is not in school if we are to prevent/minimise the spread of infection.
- School **must** be informed if you no longer fall within the critical worker list or you have been asked to self-isolate.
- Thorough hand washing to take place at home just before leaving the home.
- Children must be dropped off between 8.40-9 am and picked up by 3pm (unless other arrangements have been made for an earlier collection with Mrs Neveu)
