Communication and Language

We will have plenty of opportunity to develop our listening skills in the classroom. We will be listening to lots of stories and retelling them to each other during Story Making. We will be talking about the stories that we are reading and answering why and how questions. We will be taking part in lots of role play in our traditional fairy tales cottage.

Physical Development

We will be learning to move our bodies in different ways during our dance sessions. We will also be practising our skills in riding bikes with Mr O'Hara's Balance Ability. We will have plenty of opportunity to develop our fine motor skills by playing with: playdough, threading and practising using scissors. PE will be on Tuesdays and Fridays.
