Physical Development

As explorers we will be looking at British wildlife and observe changes in our local environment linked to seasons and weather. As scientists and inventors, we will take part in lots of experiments and investigations from looking after pets to investigation materials. We learn how to use the laptops and iPad safely and respectfully. We will think about other technology we use in everyday life as well as record videos and sounds for stories.

Literacy

We will be looking at lots of books about dragons and non-fiction books as sea creatures. Read and write sentences to embed Phase 2 and 3 sounds and high frequency words.

Write for different purposes including lists, instructions and narratives. This term we will be writing our own narrative story inspired by The Dragon Machine and we look at more traditional tales to further develop our narrative writing skills. Develop sentence writing skills to ensure we are using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

Mathematical Development
