Dear Parents or Carers,

Home learning in Reception alternative between a Home Learning Journey with Literacy, Maths and Understanding the World tasks as well as CPG Phonic Workout; CPG Maths Workout Books and Maths Passport for rapid recall.

In order to consolidate work covered in class, Literacy, Maths and Understanding the World tasks will be set as explained below.

Reading: All children will be expected to take part in reading on a daily basis for at least 15 minutes. Pages read should be recorded and parents are asked to sign their child's Reading Record to show that daily reading has been completed. The Reading Record should be in school everyday as part of school and home communication. In addition to this, all children will have tasks in their Home Learning focused on their reading comprehension skills as well as the Phonic Workout books for blending and segmenting sounds they have learnt

Maths: All children will be given a formal piece of maths homework to be completed in the workbook they have been given.

Spellings: Spring 1 (January, 2023), children will have a list of spellings weekly which will be practiced in class. These lists will be tested every **Monday**. All children have been given a copy of the spelling lists for this term. Further copies will be found on the Reception class page of the school website.

All Home Learning will be set on Friday and must be returned to school by the following **Wednesday** for marking.
