English

We will be drafting, editing and presenting:

- Instructions
- Recounts (fiction and non- fiction)
- Our own stories
- Non-chronological reports
- Poems

We will be continuously learning new vocabulary and spellings and focusing on cursive handwriting and punctuation.

We will also continue to have focussed guided reading sessions daily, as well as focussed daily phonics sessions. Objectives from the previous term will also be covered throughout this term to enable catch up where necessary.

Science

As **Scientists** we will be exploring and learning about living things and their habitats including food chains. We will also be exploring how to look after pets and what they need to be cared for. We will also learn about fair testing and plan and carry out our own investigations. We will predict, observe, record our findings and evaluate.

History

As **Historians**, we will be looking at and finding out about the life of Queen Elizabeth II and the royal family. We will also learn about Neil Armstrong and the moon landing as well as how transport has changed over time.

Art

As **Artists** we will be studying the diverse and abstract art work of Kelly Simpson Hagen and use this to inspire our own art creation to reflect a personal version of our wonderful world.

We will also learn about the importance of Remembrance Day and use perspective to draw a field of poppies. We will also draw our earth as seen from space as well as Christmas art such as decoupage tree decorations during the lead up to Christmas.

Maths

We will be focussing on number and place value, including counting and estimating and partitioning. We will be adding and subtracting, and also exploring other areas of maths such as length and measure, money and time. We will begin to learn times tables and also focus on fluency in arithmetic. Objectives from the previous term will also be covered throughout this term to enable catch up where necessary.

Music

As **Musicians** we will be learning a harvest tune, and exploring percussion instruments through our new Charanga units.
