

## English

As authors we will be reading a wide range of fiction including *George and the Dragon*, *The Dragon Machine* and *The boy who grew dragons*. We will also read a range of poetry, including performance poetry, and non-fiction, topic related texts. We will continue to learn about how to write short and longer stories aiming to include exciting and well-chosen vocabulary. We will also be carrying out dictionary work.

We will be continuously learning new vocabulary and spellings and focusing on cursive handwriting, punctuation and grammar.

## Science

As scientists, we will be exploring the world of plants as young gardeners. We will be identifying and naming plants as well as learning how to grow our own produce. We will also be investigating a variety of materials and what materials are suitable for specific purposes. The children will also be furthering their scientific knowledge and questioning skills in our own Science Discovery Zone!

## History

As historians, we will be researching castle life and traditions and researching what a monarch is. Within our topic work we will be finding out about different Kings and queens, coats of arms, knights and jousting, rules and consequences, falconry, and jesters. We will also link with our English topic to research a variety of castles including: Caerphilly Castle - Wales, Caernarfon Castle - Wales, Windsor Castle - England, Bodiam Castle - England, Eastnor Castle - England, Edinburgh Castle - Scotland, Stirling castle - Scotland.

## Maths

As mathematicians we will continue to read, write and order numbers up to 100 and beyond. We will learn how to begin to group things in different ways and relate this to multiplication and division. We will also learn about fractions including, halves, quarters and thirds. We will learn our 2, 5 and 10 times tables using more formal methods. We will continue to learn how to add and take away and continue to use addition and subtraction in problem solving. We will be learning about odd and even, money, shape, capacity and continue to read and use simple charts and tables and make pictograms and graphs. We will also begin to learn to tell time on an analogue clock as well as continue to develop our reasoning skills and explain how we solve a variety of mathematical problems.

## Music

As musicians, we will listen with concentration to explore and evaluate a variety of music styles. We will continue to explore tuned and non tuned instruments and compare these to medieval musical instruments. We will also focus on improvisation and composition including preparing and performing our own "castle" music for our end of topic activities.

## Art and Design Technology

As artists, we will be printing; experimenting with shape and pattern, including looking at repeated patterns and different materials to make texture.

We will study the work of the Artist Arlene Bades and create prints in the style of their work.

## P.E

We will be learning how to play tennis and playing lots of team and cooperative games as well as challenging ourselves through athletics and team sports in preparation for Sports Day.

We will also be participating in a variety of medieval games and dance including Maypole dancing, Knights' challenges, jousting and archery.

## Geography

As geographers, we will learn about and understand geographical similarities and differences through studying the human and physical geography of a contrasting non-European country - The country we will be learning about is MUGURAMENO VILLAGE in ZAMBIA.

## R.E/PSHE

In RE we will be thinking about how stories and art express world views. We will explore the importance of art and stories in the lives of Christian, Hindu, Muslim and non-religious people and how they shape and express people's world views.

In PHSE we will be exploring and discussing different kinds of unkind behaviour, the difference between isolated incidents of unkind behaviour and bullying and also identifying acts of kindness and exploring what it means to be kind.

## Computing

As computer technicians, we will be learning how to use a keyboard and mouse to enter and remove text and also consider how to change the look of the text, as well as justify reasoning in making these changes. We will consider the differences between using a computer to create text, and writing text on paper.

We will also continue to learn how to stay safe online with a focus on online reputation.
